EXTENDED TECH INSPECTIONS have begun.

Anyone at Tech can do an extended tech. Once your vehicle has passed extended tech, you will be issued an Extended Tech ID Card. You will then show this ID card at the gate and not have to go to tech. There will be spot checks throughout the season. We want to be very thorough since this is a season tech. Thank you for your cooperation.

Anyone racing faster than 9.99 in the quarter mile must have an NHRA license. NHRA will now accept IHRA licenses as a crossover. Complete this ASAP.

Racers 10 seconds and slower should also get a competition number and membership. The membership gets you the accident insurance and subscription to National Dragster plus other fun things. The license gets you a bracket number that you will need if you qualify for the bracket finals.

HI- ROLLER BRACKET RACE FOR OUTLAW STREET CAR EVENT, SATURDAY, MAY 15

Bracket Racers will have their shot at the track and racing during the Outlaw Street Car Shootout Event on Sat, May 15 at CDP. Gates will open at 8a with the Hi-Roller Bracket time trials underway at 9a followed by Rd 1 of bracket competition at 12 Noon. The Hi-Roller (box and no-box on separate sides of the ladder) will feature \$2,000 to win for a modest entry fee of \$65.

NEW PROGRAM:

At the end of round one, track officials will look at the log sheets to find the **smallest true Margin of Victory (MOV)** from the combined money classes. The loser of that pair will be the chosen driver who gets a **"Security Check"** that is good for a second chance entry (Free Buy Back) into round two!

IF that racer was to go on and win their class at that race, they will also win a *DSC Alexor* wireless home security system valued at \$500! If there is a tie for smallest MOV, both racers would get second chances. The Midwest Bracket Alliance Program is being revised for the 2010 season to make it easier for the racers to participate with the elimination of the need to travel from facility to facility. "New for 2010 is a simplified program that will allow the top points competitors at each track in Super Pro and Pro class's race in a tournament style event at the end of the season" said Scott Gardner. The event in 2010 will be held at Eddyville Raceway Park on Sat, Oct 9, 2010 (1/8 mile).

2010 PROGRAM OUTLINE

- Five (5) vehicles per class per track based on your home track points, will qualify for MBA Finals (Super Pro & Pro Classes) – Total 15 entries.
- Only one (1) vehicle can be entered one time (not used for both classes).
- Only one driver can be qualified one time (can't drive in both classes).
- No separate administration fee will be charged for the MBA Series.
- A modest entry and payout will be established for both classes at the MBA Finals.

The winners in Super and Pro classes at the MBA Finals will receive the "MBA Dream Package".

CDP 2010 POINTS POLICY

- Any racer may join the points program at Cordova Dragway Park. A racer can join points at any time during the season and points will start accumulating once they join. If they join by Points race #2 on May 8th, a racer will earn points retroactive from points Race #1. A racer must be a points member to race at the Bracket Team Finals and to receive year end points fund monies.
- This includes Super Pro, Pro ET, Super ET, Street, Bike, and Juniors
- A racer earns points - 10 pts for entering and 10 pts for each round win. The winner of each race will earn 2 additional points and the runner-up will earn 1 additional point.
- BONUS POINTS: Sunday points day of World Series will be 20 points to enter and 11 points per round win.
- No Team drivers allowed.
- Once a class has been declared you may not transfer points between classes.
- The points go with the Driver and their number. We don't care what you drive in your class so long as you have your number on the entry. It is good to check your ET slip to make sure your car number is correct – this will insure that you get proper credit for your rounds.
- NEW = This year we will drop the lowest 2 races of the season. If a racer attends all points race during the season, as a bonus, they will only drop 1 (one) of the lowest races of the season.
- If you have any questions about your points please contact the office as soon as you have a question. We try to get them posted on the website by Wednesday following the points races. The points are hand tabulated and there can be mistakes. If you wait until the last race it may be too late to fix the problem.

Points Membership Program ~Team Green

Points will be awarded to members in Super Pro, Pro ET, Super ET, True Street, Pro Bike and Junior Dragster classes. The enrollment fee is \$60 per entry and \$30 for Juniors. Thirtysix (36) entries plus four high school entries will represent CDP at The 2010 NHRA Division Team Bracket Finals in Topeka, KS on Sept 16-19 (in 2011 the Team Finals will be in Brainerd, MN). The points standings through Sept 11th (Pts Race #13) will determine the qualifiers for the team. The team composition will be determined from memberships on a per class basis. Juniors have a separate race. Enrollment includes eligibility for the cash points fund, and if you qualify and attend the bracket finals you will get your Points Membership entry fee returned, receive a Team shirt, and Team party and all the fun you can stand.
